

# St. Joseph's Corner

I pray that you are all having a good Lent. This week, the third week of Lent, the Liturgy of the Word includes a well-known Gospel passage, John 2:13-24, Jesus Clears the Temple Courts.

The traders and money changers provided an essential service. Many would have traveled great distances to worship at the temple, and they would likely need to exchange their local currency for currency used to pay the temple tax. Likewise, the expense of bringing sacrificial animals on a long journey would have been too high for most people. The convenience of purchasing these animals outside the temple would have been significant.

Jesus took issue not with the changing of money or the sale of animals but rather with where these transactions occurred and how they impeded people from worshiping God.

For the Jewish people, the temple would have been equivalent to the Tabernacle in our churches—the dwelling place of God. This context helps us understand why Jesus said, "...stop making My Father's house a place of business!" John 2:16. The tables of money changers and sellers of sacrificial animals would have been in the area of the temple designated for worship by non-Jews.

It is easy to interpret this text as Jesus giving a justification for righteous anger, Jesus showing the world how tough He is, or as a teaching to not exchange money in the church. These would all be easy interpretations except for the fact each is wholly inconsistent with Jesus as depicted throughout the bible. We should delve deeper into the meaning of the passage.

The temple and the act of sacrifice had become a business. While the function of the business was necessary, its profits were predicated on keeping people from worshiping God. The system was especially harmful to the poor and marginalized. But, above all, this business, built on the worship of God, became a mechanism of power and profit—most literally, a false idol.

#### **Our Call as Christians**

We do many things every day that are neither holy nor evil. Many of us enjoy watching or playing sports, fishing, or an assortment of other hobbies. We have household chores and errands. But nothing we do should ever stand in the way of loving God and loving our neighbor. Nothing we do should impede someone else from loving God or their neighbor.

As husbands and fathers, we must orient our lives to put God first. Just as we can learn from the example of St. Joseph, so too can our families learn from our example.
