

SHROUDED IN VIOLET




The Fifth Sunday of Lent is known as Passion Sunday and the start of 'Passiontide'. Traditionally, Catholic Churches cover statues, crosses, and sacred images with violet cloths. This practice serves as a reminder of Christ hiding his divinity while giving us a sense of longing for the Resurrection with the absence of Christ and the saints during the intense days of the Passion.

A WORD FROM FR. GREG

Dear Parishioners,

During this holy season of Lent, we should focus on three traditional pillars of our observance: prayer, penance, and almsgiving. These practices are opportunities to draw closer to Christ and prepare our hearts for the joy of the

Resurrection.

Prayer is the foundation of our relationship with God. If you are looking to deepen your prayer life, I invite you to visit our 24-hour Adoration Chapel, with keypad access, located on the northeast side of the building. The chapel offers a quiet sanctuary for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament at any hour of the day or night.

Penance: We will hold our Lenten Reconciliation Service on March 27 at 7:00 PM. The format remains the same as previous years, with entry through the Adoration Chapel door and bilingual priests ready to hear your Confession in the Church. This will be the last opportunity for confession before Easter.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation cleanses our souls and restores us with God's grace. After absolution, we can truly celebrate Easter by receiving the Eucharist worthily. It is a chance to experience His endless mercy.

Almsgiving: When we hear "almsgiving," we often think of monetary donations. However, true Catholic stewardship includes giving our time and talents as much as our treasure. Our parish family is currently in need of Liturgical Ministers and Collection Counters.

Volunteering your time is a sacrificial form of almsgiving that benefits our entire parish community while still allowing you to maintain a flexible schedule. Please consider offering your gifts to serve the Lord and your fellow parishioners. Contact the office for more information if you can apply your gifts and talents to one of these ministries.

Parish Mission: As you already know, we are excited to have Fr. Tom McCarthy, OSA, leading our English-speaking Parish Mission. He will guide us through Prayer, the Saints, and how to become a more active and engaged member of our parish family.

We welcome everyone to attend this event from Sunday, March 22nd, through Tuesday, the 24th, at 7 pm. We were blessed by Fr. Pawel's mission, and now we have another opportunity to grow in faith as a community.

Drodzy Parafianie,

W tym świętym czasie Wielkiego Postu powinniśmy skupić się na trzech tradycyjnych filarach naszej pobożności: modlitwie, pokucie i jałmużnie. Praktyki te są okazją do zbliżenia się do Chrystusa i przygotowania naszych serc na radość Zmartwychwstania.

Modlitwa jest fundamentem naszej relacji z Bogiem. Jeśli pragniecie pogłębić swoje życie modlitewne, zapraszam do odwiedzenia naszej Kaplicy Wieczystej Adoracji, dostępnej przez całą dobę (wejście na kod), znajdującej się po północno-wschodniej stronie budynku. Kaplica ta jest miejscem ciszy i skupienia, gdzie można modlić się przed Najświętszym Sakramentem o każdej porze dnia i nocy.

Pokuta: Nabożeństwo pokutne w okresie Wielkiego Postu odbędzie się 27 marca o godz. 19:00. Forma pozostaje taka sama jak w latach ubiegłych – wejście przez drzwi Kaplicy Adoracji, a w kościele będą obecni kapłani dwujęzyczni, gotowi do wysłuchania spowiedzi. Będzie to ostatnia okazja do spowiedzi przed Wielkanocą.

Sakrament pokuty oczyszcza nasze dusze i przywraca nas do łaski Bożej. Po otrzymaniu rozgrzeszenia możemy prawdziwie świętować Wielkanoc, godnie przyjmując Eucharystię. Jest to okazja do doświadczenia nieskończonego miłosierdzia Boga.

Jałmużna: Kiedy słyszymy słowo „jałmużna”, często myślimy o darowiznach pieniężnych. Jednak prawdziwa katolicka troska o Kościół obejmuje nie tylko ofiarowanie środków materialnych, ale także naszego czasu i talentów. Nasza parafia obecnie potrzebuje osób do posługi liturgicznej oraz do liczenia składek.

Ofiarowanie swojego czasu jest formą ofiary, która przynosi dobro całej wspólnoty parafialnej, a jednocześnie pozwala na elastyczne zaangażowanie. Prosimy o rozważenie możliwości wykorzystania swoich darów w służbie Bogu i bliźnim. W celu uzyskania dodatkowych informacji prosimy o kontakt z biurem parafialnym.

Rekolekcje parafialne: Jak już wiecie, cieszymy się z wizyty ks. Toma McCarthy, OSA, który poprowadzi anglojęzyczne rekolekcje parafialne. Poprowadzi nas przez temat modlitwy, świętych oraz pokaże, jak stać się bardziej aktywnym i zaangażowanym członkiem naszej wspólnoty.

Serdecznie zapraszamy wszystkich do udziału w tym wydarzeniu od niedzieli 22 marca do wtorku 24 marca o godz. 19:00. Zostaliśmy ubogaceni rekolekcjami, które prowadził ks. Paweł, i teraz mamy kolejną okazję, aby wzrastać w wierze jako wspólnota.



Lenten Family Activity

Set out a glass jar for each family member. Determine, as a family, which behavior will correspond with each jellybean color. Each day family members earn a jellybean of any color by doing the specific behaviors assigned to each jelly bean color.

Don't eat the jellybeans until Easter!

White jellybeans cannot be earned as these represent the Grace of Christ, which is God's gift to us, not something we can earn.

This is how you may wish to interpret each color.

- Red is for the blood Christ gave (each morning choose something to sacrifice that day to earn the red jellybean. It had to be something they would have had the opportunity to have or do on that day).

- Green is for the palm's cool shade (green jellybeans were earned for good deeds. It was a good deed to provide shade for Jesus with the palm).

- Yellow is for God's light so bright (yellow jellybeans were earned for sharing God's light through kindness to others).

- Orange is for praying together (orange jellybeans were earned for attentive behavior and for each time families pray together).

- White is for the Grace of Christ (God's gift to us).

- Purple is for His days of sorrow (earned these through apologizing to anyone we hurt with our words or deeds that day).

- Pink is for each new tomorrow (pink jellybeans were earned when we forgave those who apologized to us for hurtful behavior).

These "Lenten behaviors" will become part of your family routine. Families that pray together, stay together

St. Joseph's Corner

The Gospel passage recounting the death of Lazarus, the brother of Martha and Mary, will be preached in parishes around the world this Sunday. It is often presented as a foreshadowing of Jesus's own death and resurrection—and rightly so. The account not only anticipates the events to come but also reveals a fundamental truth about Sacred Scripture: across centuries and through many human authors, Scripture consistently points to Christ from the very beginning through typology and the fulfillment of divine promise.

The parallels are unmistakable to Christians from antiquity to the present day. Yet we approach this passage with an advantage the first hearers did not possess: we know the Resurrection long before we encounter this moment in St. John's Gospel. Even before Jesus's own death, however, the power of this sign begins to reveal who He truly is. John tells us that after witnessing what had occurred, many of the Jews who had "...seen what he had done began to believe in him" (Jn 11:45).

The past two reflections have considered the first two Scrutinies. This week, we turn to the third: "the Resurrection and the Life." In those earlier passages, we saw a progression of revelation and understanding. Both the Samaritan woman and the man born blind gradually come to recognize who Christ is—first encountering Him as a man, and later confessing Him as Lord. Here we observe a similar progression, now across all three Scrutinies together. Each addresses a distinct human condition and presents Christ as the only enduring answer. The first begins with thirst—both physical and spiritual. To the Samaritan woman, Christ reveals Himself as the Living Water, the source capable of satisfying the deepest longing of the human heart....

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled on the second Sunday of each month. Polish Baptisms are at 1:00 p.m., and English Baptisms are at 1:30 p.m. Please contact the Faith Formation Office before booking a venue for the celebration. Parents must be registered with our parish. Both sponsors must be over 16 years old, with at least one being a practicing Catholic.



Marriage: The bride and groom should be active members of our parish. The couple should contact the Faith Formation Office at least six months in advance to schedule their marriage, allowing for adequate preparation. Schedule the church date for your marriage before securing your venue.



Funerals: The family of the deceased will coordinate with the chosen funeral home to make the arrangements. The funeral home will then contact the Faith Formation Office at Our Mother of Good Counsel (OMGC) to notify us about the upcoming funeral Mass. We (OMGC) will get in touch with the family and work together to organize the funeral liturgy.



Eucharist for the Homebound and Hospitalized: If you are unable to attend Mass please contact the Parish Office for the Sacraments of the Eucharist. Our Homebound ministry would be happy to assist you.



Anointing of the Sick & Hospital Visits: Please contact the Parish Office if your loved one requires an anointing. Please do not wait until death is imminent to request anointing, as it may take some time to find a priest for the sacrament.



Religious Education: We offer religious education classes for grades 1-8. Call the Faith Formation Office for more information. Classes meet Wednesday, 6:00-7:30PM September through March.
